Day 1: This morning we begin our hands-on culinary journey with **A Taste of Lancaster.** The first stop will be to the quaint town of Litiz, PA. Here we will enjoy lunch paired with a tasting of 3 draft beers, on tap at the **Appalachian Brewing Company**. Originally founded in 1997 in Harrisburg, this location is housed in the Litiz Junction Building, previously home to both a paper-box factory and the Clair Brothers, one of the most respected sound, light, and staging companies in the world. Our next stop is **Wilbur Chocolates**, where you walk in, take a deep breath, and smell the chocolate aroma throughout the store. The candy store offers an atmosphere that will stir delightful memories of yesteryear and put a smile on your face. We might even get a chance to see the candy makers in action. This afternoon we head for our hotel, **The Cork Factory Hotel**, located right in Lancaster. This 19th Century building once housed the historic Armstrong Cork and Kerr Glass Companies. **Dinner** is included this evening at the **Fireside Tavern**. (L, D)

Day 2: A **full breakfast buffet** is included before we travel throughout Lancaster County, the home of Pennsylvania's Amish and Mennonite people. We begin our day at **Kitchen Kettle Village**, which started as a single canning business in 1954, for a flavorful '*food fight*' and *hands-on whoopie pie making experience*. After we depart and head to a painting party with an instructor from **Zolē Art Factory**, who will guide us through our own outlook on Lancaster. Dinner is served at **Miller's Smorgasbord**, before taking our reserved orchestra seats at **Sight & Sound Theatre for their** *NEW* **production of** "**JESUS.**" '*JESUS*' is an action-packed musical stage adventure – a journey alongside the most important person to ever walk the earth, and the everyday people whose lives he transformed forever. Day 3: From **breakfast**, we say good-bye to Lancaster and continue our journey into Hershey, PA. We start our day at the **Mount Hope Estate and Winery**, for a light lunch paired with a wine and beer tasting. The Mansion was originally built in 1800's as a private home, but is now a flourishing historic estate. This afternoon we travel home with flavorful thoughts and memories of Lancaster County PA.
