## Québec Winter Carnival

\* Québec Observatory \* Sainte-Annede-Beaupré Basilica \* Hôtel de Glace \* Bonhomme's Ice Palace

February 1 – 4, 2018 4 days / 3 nights

Day 1: This morning we depart Old Lyme at 7:45AM on a journey that takes us north into the St. Lawrence River Valley and the city of Quebec, Canada, which will be buzzing with the excitement of the Winter Carnival. Our hotel is the beautiful 4-star Palace Royal, located at the St. John Gate to the Walled City. Dinner this evening is included in the Steak House Restaurant at the Palace Royal. (D)

Day 2: Along with a local guide we will visit Old Québec City, stroll through the center of the first permanent colony in New France, marvel at the immense Fresque de Québéçois, and be charmed by the Quartier Petit Champlain. There's a lot of history here. We'll then head to the Québec Observatory to admire Québec City from 221 meters up, the highest point in the city! Lunch today is included at the Restaurant le Parlementaire, a stunning beaux arts dining room with a menu prepared using produce and honey gathered from the Parliament gardens and beehives. Our sightseeing continues this afternoon with a visit to the Beaupré Coast, the Route de la Nouvelle France, St. Anne de Beaupre Basilica, and Montmorency Falls. Dinner tonight is included at the Café de Paris in the historic Walled City. (B, L, D)

Day 3: Today, after breakfast, we'll be visiting the Winter Carnival with our local guide! Our day will start at the enchanting Hôtel de Glace, a full hotel constructed from ice. After free time for lunch, our guide will take us to stroll on the Boardwalk at Dufferin Terrace by the Château Frontenac, the world's most photographed hotel. The rest of the afternoon will be given over to free time to explore the Winter Carnival – be sure to check out the Snow Sculptures and Bonhomme's Ice Palace!\* This evening we'll enjoy the Winter Carnival's Night Parade from the VIP Section, seated on a front stage. Witness a world of fantasy and imagination as winter celebrations take over the streets of Quebec City. (B)

Day 4: We're homeward bound today, so we'll have to say bonjour et adieu to Quebec City! We'll stop for bargain shopping at Duty Free. It's been a magical four days and an experience we will never forget! Return to Waterford in the evening.
