

*In the event of adverse weather conditions, the dinner at Isola dei Pescatori may be held at your hotel instead.

**Isola Bella and the Borromeo Palace are open from April 1 to October 31. If you are travelling between November 1 and March 31, you will enjoy a scenic cruise of the Borromean Islands and a visit to Pallanza village instead. If you are in Lake Maggiore between April 1-15 the Borromeo Palace might be closed mid-week.

***Your visit to Murano Island may be substituted with a visit to a local glass factory in Venice in the event of inclement weather.

Zacchera Hotels is a hotel chain in Lago Maggiore. The exact hotel to be used will be available 15 days prior to the tour departure date.

The overall activity level of this tour is a level 2. This means you like a balanced approach to travel. You feel confident walking at least 30-45 minutes at a time over a variety of terrains – from cobblestone streets to easy straightaways to a couple hills or flights of stairs. You're comfortable walking a few city blocks at a time, but need some time to unwind and relax.

In particular, you should expect large crowds in Venice, which requires about 2 miles of walking over cobblestoned streets and negotiating steps up and down 8-10 bridges with 15-20 steps each. For your visit of Venice, agility is required to board motorboats to Murano and St. Mark's Square. If you require a walker or wheelchair, or have difficulty walking, you may not be able to access some of these areas and may want to consider an alternate tour.

Please be advised many airlines do not provide advance seat assignments until check-in at the airport. Advance seating will be subject to the airline's terms and conditions.

Our air passengers will arrive into Milan Malpensa airport. All arrival transfers will depart from Milan airport for Lake Maggiore. Our air passengers will depart from Venice airport. All return transfers will depart from Treviso for Venice airport.

Economy air rate and schedule are applicable for groups of 10 or more traveling on the same flights and dates.

A deposit of \$600 per person is due upon reservation. Reservations are made on a first come, first served basis. Reservations made after the deposit due date of April 01, 2023 are based upon availability. Final payment due by August 08, 2023. Deposits are refundable up until April 08, 2023.

**Leonardo's Last Supper fresco is one of Milan's most popular sites and is located in the refectory of the Santa Maria delle Grazie Church. Tickets are in high demand and are difficult to obtain on the day or close to the day of visit. If you are interested, we recommend that you purchase tickets online in advance through the official website of Cenacolo Vinciano Vivaticket. Tickets should be purchased for the afternoon of your first or second day in Milan.

Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first come, first served basis.

The overall activity level of this extension is a level 3. This means walking and standing for longer periods of time (1-2 hours) isn't a big deal for you. You can navigate hills and uneven ground, climb into various modes of transportation (tuk-tuk, cable car, Zodiac, etc.), and could possibly anticipate changes in elevation. You can expect some longer days balanced with free-time to recharge or set out on your own adventure.
